St Michael's was happy to recommence our school assemblies this week with birthday certificates and merit awards being presented.

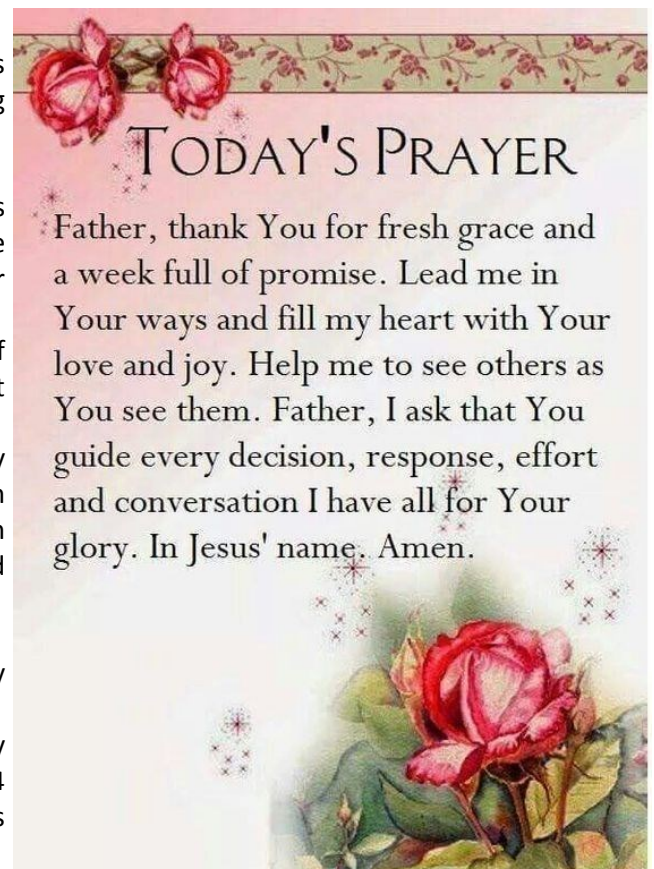
