We are all pleased that we can now celebrate Sunday Mass in our Parish of Brunswick. We look forward to our students being able to participate in junior sport in the coming weeks.


We remind parents that they are most welcome to enter the school during pick up and drop off times. However, entering classrooms is still a restriction.






SCHOOL FUN RUN
