Next Monday we will celebrate Book Week. There will be a book display for students to peruse.

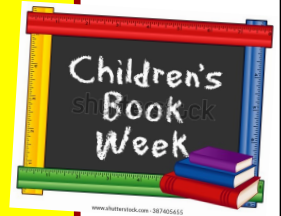
Book Week Opening Times
