Advise the Principal with respect to school policy.

A keenness to promote Catholic schooling

A deep interest in the welfare of all students and staff

A desire to give service to the Catholic School Community

The ability to work cooperatively and constructively with all members of the Board

A sufficiency of time to devote to Board duties. (Board Meetings are held once a month.) Membership of the School Board will be for a period of two years.
